ARTS FOR RUTLAND (RUTLAND ARTS YOUTH) VIRTUAL EXHIBITION CONDITIONS AND PROCEDURES (Please retain this for future reference)

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, The Arts for Rutland (Rutland Arts Youth) Exhibition for 2021 will be an online exhibition

THE THEME FOR 2021 is “OPEN THE DOOR”

Eligibility

All young Artists, living, or at school in Rutland between the ages of 11 and 18 are invited to enter this Exhibition. Works will be accepted in the following mediums - painting, drawing, ceramic, sculpture and textiles.

Photography is not permitted for this year's exhibition.

Prizes

Prizewinners will be notified by email on 9th April 2021 and identified on the Arts for Rutland website.

Entry and procedure

Each artist may enter up to two works. All works must be original. Selected works will be displayed on the Arts for Rutland website and associated social media pages. ENTRY IS FREE. All submissions to be submitted virtually by a responsible adult, on behalf of the candidate, via the link available on the Arts for Rutland website <https://www.a4r.org.uk/rutland-open-youth/>

Entries must be submitted on or before 19th March 2021

Submission requirements

Only original work will be accepted.

Maximum acceptable file size for the submission of work is **strictly 10Mb**. Submissions must include:

- 1a A clear, high quality photograph of each piece separately, where the work fills as much of the photograph as possible. The work must be photographed in front of a plain background and, where possible, must be the only object in view.
- 1b Where the submission is of a 3-D piece of work (i.e. a sculpture), a second photograph of the artwork from a different angle may be submitted
- 2 All applicants **MUST** also submit a good quality image of the work with the artist standing next to it. If there is more than one piece being submitted, then photographs with each piece must be taken for each - Photographs of the young artist with their original piece will not be published on any platform, this is entirely for verification purposes of the original works.

Files larger than 10Mb will be turned away, please note there is no minimum size for inclusion. You must check that the work in the photograph is submitted the right way up.

Photographs of the artwork being submitted are to be sent to rutlandartsyouth@gmail.com. The subject of the email **MUST** include the Artwork Title and Artist's surname and all photographs **MUST** be sent from the responsible adult's email address

The file name for each photograph must include the title of the work and the applicant's surname, for example, if 'Looking Through the Door' may be labelled as '**LookingThrough.Smith(1).jpeg**' with the authentication photograph labelled '**LookingThrough.Smith(2).jpeg**'

Selection

By a panel of professional external Judges. The selection panel's decision is final, as is the placing of work.

Publicity

Arts for Rutland reserves the right to save and publish the submitted photographs for education and publicity purposes, including on our website and connected social media pages (Facebook, Twitter and Instagram).

Each young artist will receive an email notification once the exhibition has gone live on the Arts for Rutland website, including information of any awards that they may win.
